Criteria for entry

All entrants, or nominating Principal or colleague, must submit an application, and brief case study, outlining the additional work they undertake, above and beyond the classroom. The case study must include evidence of the significant impact on the school, classrooms and student wellbeing.

Entrants must also:

- be an educator in a CEDP school,
- secure permission and/or a reference from their Principal or suitable reporting manager,
- agree to take part in media promotion,
- ensure students faces are not be displayed in the video entry for child protection and permission reasons,
- agree to the Terms and Conditions and Eligibility Criteria,
- agree to participate in the Bank's and the CEDP's publicity and promotional initiatives,
- agree to receive electronic communications from the Bank keeping them up to date with news, information on products, services and promotions via email and/or phone, and

The following are not eligible to enter:
