- SAVE** - Money you keep for later and when you've saved enough you can buy something you really, really want. And when you have big amounts of money, deposit them in the bank to keep them safe and earn interest.
- SPEND** - Fun money. This is money you can keep in your pocket to use anytime.
- INVEST** - This is money you save for when you're much older. This can be a hard concept for little kids to grasp but it's a word older kids will hear. If you have primary school kids, just stick to 'save', 'spend', 'give'.
- GIVE** - This jar is for 'kind' money. Money that you put aside for people, kids and animals that need your help.

What you'll need:

- 4 empty jars
- string or ribbon
- scissors



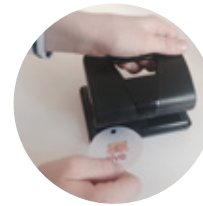
Step 1:

Print out the activity sheet.
Find 4 empty jars or containers that have a lid.
TIP: If you're using old jam jars, soak them in water overnight to make it easy to take the label off.



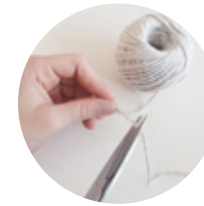
Step 2:

Cut out the labels.
There are different labels to choose from.



Step 3:

Use a hole punch to make a hole in the top of your label. Or you can just glue them straight on to the jar.



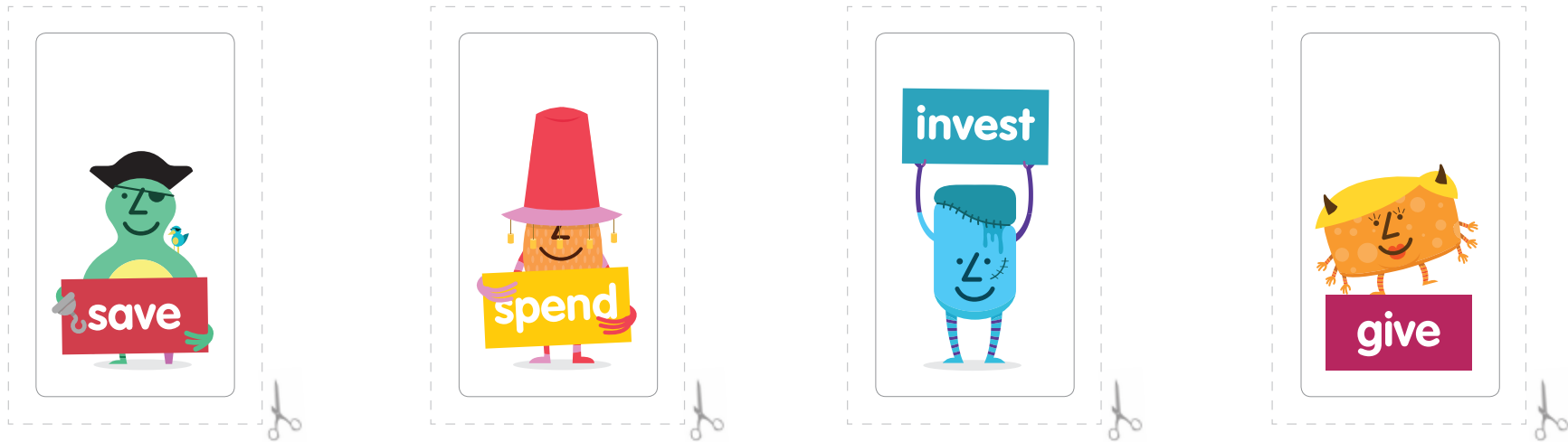
Step 4:

Cut the string and tie the labels onto the jars.
Start putting your money in the jars.
